Lesson Structure and Procedures

The sequence of the lesson elements

The before, during, and after of the lesson (e.g., the engagement/opening, procedures, guided practice, and conclusion)

Instructional Strategies

The approaches that will be used to help students achieve the learning objectives and that best meet students' needs

Learning Activities

The opportunities that will be provided for students to develop the knowledge and skills targeted by the learning objectives



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Resources and Materials

A list of the materials to be used in the planning of the lesson and during instruction

Technology

The instructional and/or assistive technology that will be incorporated into the lesson to enhance instruction and student learning

Differentiation/Accommodations/Modifications

The differentiation/accommodations/modifications that will help meet the needs of all learners by addressing learning differences, cultural and language differences, etc.



Classroom Management

Strategies that are consistent with the learning needs of the lesson, that meet student behavior needs, and that will be used to help keep the students on task and actively engaged

Extensions

Activities for early finishers that extend the students' understanding of and thinking about the learning objectives by applying their new knowledge in different ways

Follow-Up Activity

A quick activity (which may be incorporated either the day after the lesson or throughout the unit) for reviewing or building on the day's learning, deepening student understanding, and/or interconnecting concepts
