If c is the hypotenuse of the right triangle ABC , find the missing side length. Write your answer in simplest radical form. No decimals.

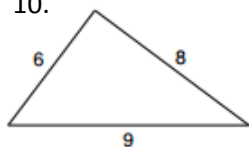
